If you currently have such a commitment in place to benefit the school, you are already eligible for recognition in the Society. Please notify the Office of Development in the IU School of Liberal Arts.

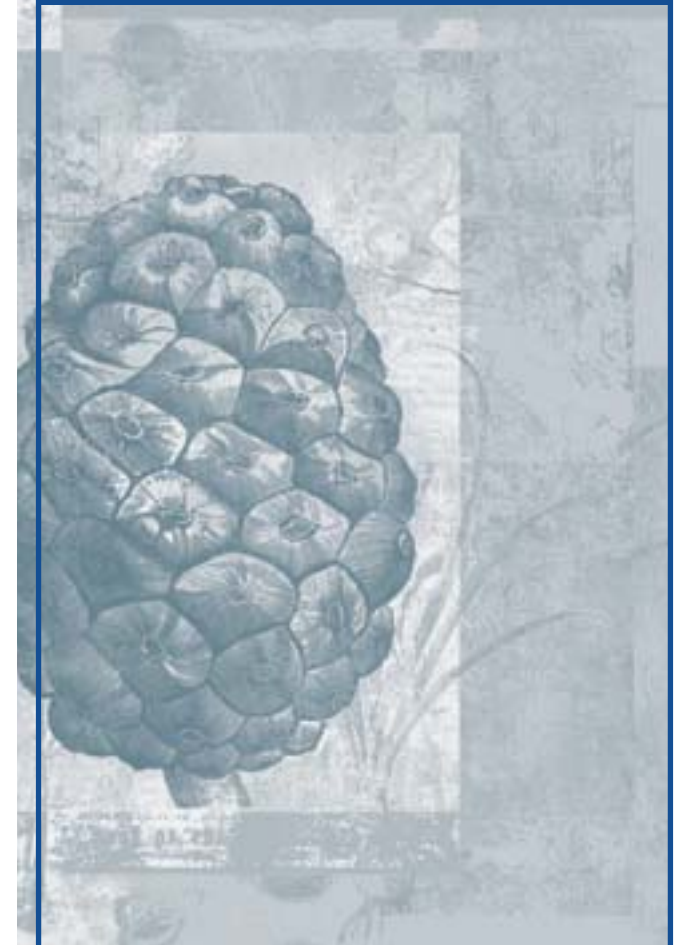

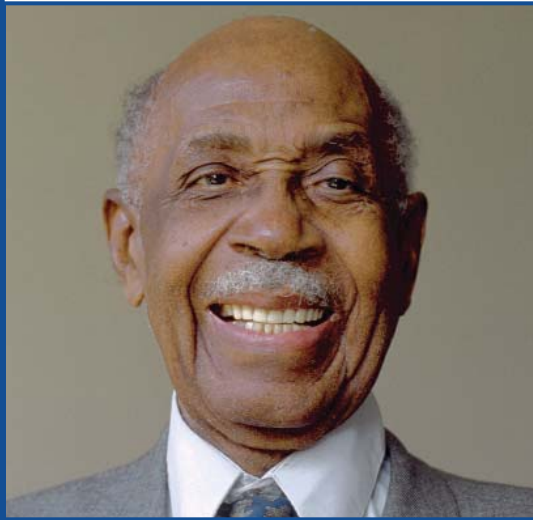

## DR. JOSEPH T. TAYLOR



When Joseph T. Taylor and his family settled in Indianapolis in 1957, they entered a lifelong partnership with both a city and a university characterized by unprecedented growth, change and development.

His earliest association with Indiana University was as an associate faculty member at IU's legendary "Downtown Campus." He later led that campus as its dean, guiding it through the transition to what is now IUPUI.

Dr. Taylor was the founding dean of the IU School of Liberal Arts and served as professor of sociology. His devotion to the creation of an educational environment to meet the needs of widely diverse populations in central Indiana helped shape what is now considered a model in urban higher education—IUPUI. His is a truly important legacy.
